



## PURE HOCKEY GOALTENDING



### Goaltender Private Lesson Contract

#### **It would be expected that *the goaltender would*:**

- (a) Promote my instruction to other goaltenders through their parents.
- (b) Ice time and all applicable taxes are included in the private instruction pricing.
- (c) Times and dates are to be discussed based on ice time availability of the goalie and me.
- (d) Provide payment to me for my services at the fixed rates set out below. *Please indicate.*
  - \* 1:1 Instruction - \$ 200.00 per goalie based on 1 hour of on ice instruction
  - \* 2:1 Instruction - \$ 160.00 per goalie based on 1 hour of on ice instruction
  - \* 3:1 Instruction - \$ 140.00 per goalie based on 1 hour of on ice instruction
  - \* 4:1 Instruction - \$ 120.00 per goalie based on 1 hour of on ice instruction
- (e) Make payment in full to PHG at the time of booking the sessions.
- (f) Should a session need to be canceled, the following applies:
  - \* Less than 24 hours notice, loss of session and cost of ice will be billed as used.
  - \* 24 + hours, time will be re-scheduled and this session will be used towards block
- (g) Be on time for each scheduled ice time.
- (h) Shooters are at the responsibility of the goaltender. If you would like me to arrange for shooters, a charge may apply for the shooters. This will be at the expense of the goalie. Shooters must be of same or higher skill level to ensure goaltenders are challenged. No more than two shooters will be needed at anytime.

#### **The following expectations apply to me. *I would*:**

- (a) Tailor my instruction to apply to the skill level of the goalies using modern and proven techniques.
- (b) Book the necessary ice time for the private lesson if required to do so.
- (c) Maintain player and parent confidentiality at all times.
- (d) Maintain strict role separation at all times. I will not become involved in or offer advice in relation to the physical or mental aspects of the players' game. If asked to do so, I will recommend suitable personnel to assist in this area. The focus will be solely on the 'technical' aspects of the game.
- (e) Expect parents to complete and sign a registration form that gathers basic demographic information on goalies enrolling in the course ( name, age, medical conditions etc) and identifies some basic expectations regarding the training setting of the course.
- (f) Meet with you (goalie and parents) at the conclusion of the session to brief you on what's been covered on the ice so that you can convey and reinforce the application of the skills being learned in the training sessions to the coach.
